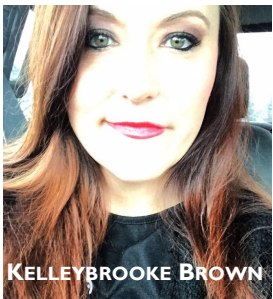

educational experiences through competitions, main stage productions, festivals, workshops, and clubs.

Camp participants will receive instruction in the areas of acting, voice, choreography, & technical theatre. Youth wishing to apply

for the **RDT SUMMER YOUTH CAMP** must be entering the 8th-12th grades in the fall. They should submit an essay (no more than 750 words) stating why they want to participate in the camp and include any experience or training received in theatrical arts or music. Recommendations from teachers are strongly encouraged. A panel of judges will select the 15 best qualified applicants. Financial aid for the camp may be awarded to applicants based on available funding and compliance with requirements. Youth not meeting financial aid requirements are welcome to apply and will be accepted on a "first come" basis upon receipt of application and the \$200 registration fee.

Camp hours are Monday, June 17th, through Saturday, June 22nd from 8:45 a.m. to 4:45 p.m., culminating in a public performance of **GODSPELL JUNIOR** on Saturday, June 22nd, at 7 p.m.

Camp applications must be postmarked by Friday, May 31, 2019, and mailed to TCBC, PO Box 5236, Union Springs, AL 36089 or hand-delivered to the Tourism Council office at 106 E.
