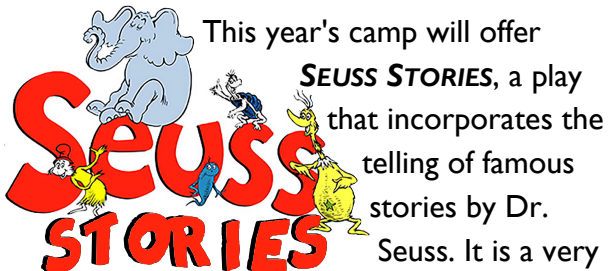

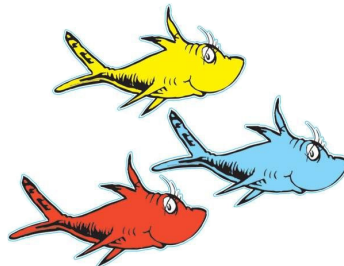

Auditions will be held Saturday, May 4, from 10-11 a.m., and Monday, May 6, from 6-7 p.m. Children must attend one of the auditions. A maximum of 20 children will be selected to participate in the camp.

Camp hours are Sunday, June 2 (parents only) , from 4-5 p.m., and Monday-Friday, June 3-7, from 8:45 a.m.-12:15 p.m. The week will culminate with the performance of **Seuss Stories** on Friday, June 7, at 7 p.m.

Children are to wear camp style clothes—t-shirt, shorts, and sneakers (no open-toed shoes)—and bring a healthy snack & water with their name on it.

Camp applications must be postmarked by April 15, 2019, and mailed to TCBC, PO Box 5236, Union Springs, AL 36089, or hand-delivered to the Tourism Council Office at 106 E. Conecuh Avenue by that date.
