Camp hours are Sunday, June 10, from 4-5 p.m., and Monday-Friday, June 11-15, from 8:45 a.m.-12:15 p.m. The week will culminate with the performance of a one-act play on Friday, June 15, at 7 p.m., and Saturday, June 16, at 10:00 a.m. (if necessary).

Children are to wear camp style clothes—t-shirt, shorts, and sneakers (no open-toed shoes)—and bring a healthy snack & water with their name on it.
